## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including Appendix B and Appendix BB
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of the Canadian national authority will not apply: Appendix G – Identification on Sails.
- 1.3 IKA Championship Rules 2012 – Course Racing will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's) the SI's shall take precedence.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Competitors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3 ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to competitors in the PRO and KOOK classes
- 3.2 It is recommended that competitors *should* be members of a National Kiteboarding Class Association which is a paid up member of the IKA
- 3.3 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the Entry Form that will be available at the Royal Victoria Yacht Club website by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Entry forms must be received before midnight June 20th, 2013.
- 3.4 A maximum of 25 entries will be accepted per Class
- 3.5 A fee will be charged cover both days of racing, prize giving & a Saturday night BBQ at the RVYC-\$50.
- 3.6 All entrants must wear a high contrast jersey with two numbers at least 35 cm high, and 3cm thick on both the front and back. This jersey must be worn over top of all gear. If this jersey is not clearly visible, the contestant may not be scored.

### 4 CLASSES

- 4.1 Competitors using race boards must compete in the PRO Class.
- 4.2 Competitors using anything else (surfboards/ coffee tables/ twin tips) must compete in the KOOK class.
- 4.3 Each Class will use the same windward/leeward course, but will have separate starting times. Starts will alternate PRO/KOOK

### 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 All competitors should meet at Clover Point area at 12:00 each day for a competitors meeting.
- 5.2 Dates of racing: June 22, 23rd
- 5.3 A maximum of 3 races per class will be run per day.
- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 13:00. No races shall be started after 18:00.
- 5.6 On Saturday night, a BBQ will commence at the Royal Victoria Yacht Club as soon as possible after the last race.
- 5.6 On Sunday night, prize giving will commence at the Royal Victoria Yacht Club as soon as possible after the finish of the last race.

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available online at the Royal Victoria Yacht Club website by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **7 VENUE**

- 7.1 The event will be held in the waters adjacent to Clover Point, Victoria BC. Launching will be from the beach on the west side of the point. Directions to the site can be found at

- 9.1 Prizes will be given as follows, but may be changed subject to availability:

- PRO Class – Prizes for top 3 finishers
- KOOK Tip Class – Prizes for top 2 finishers, and for last overall KOOK.
